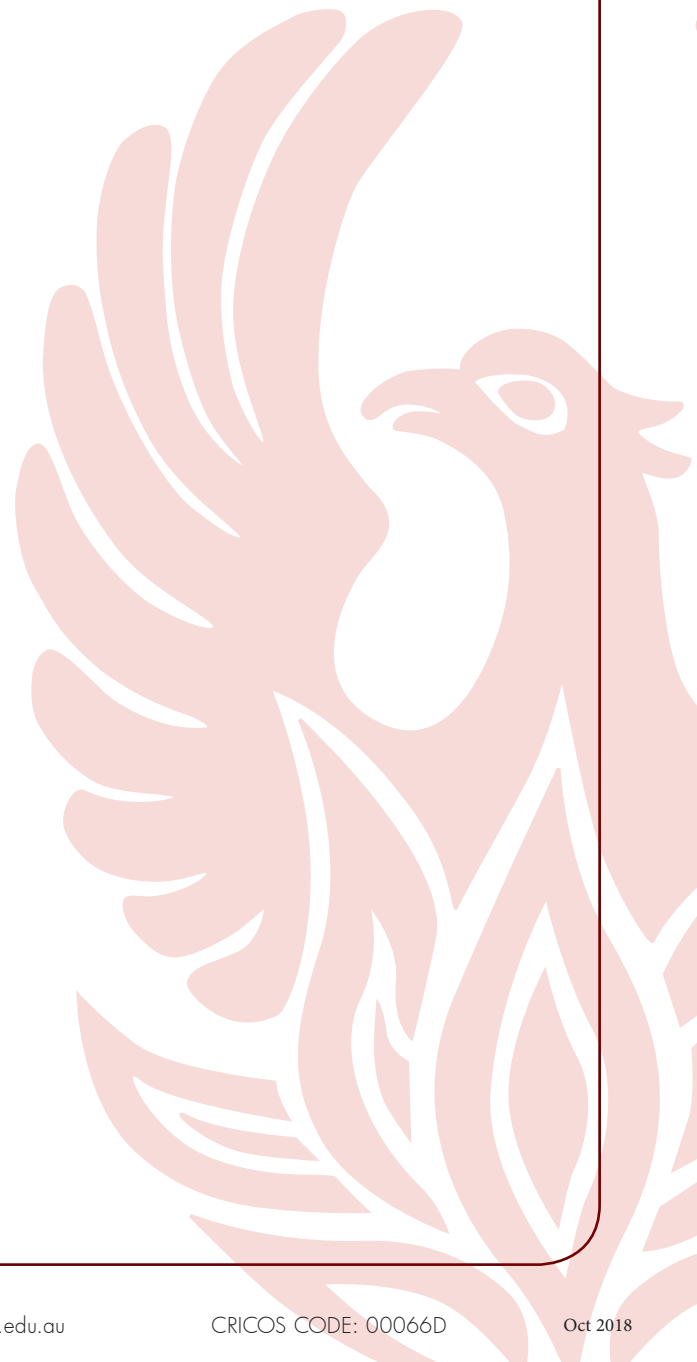

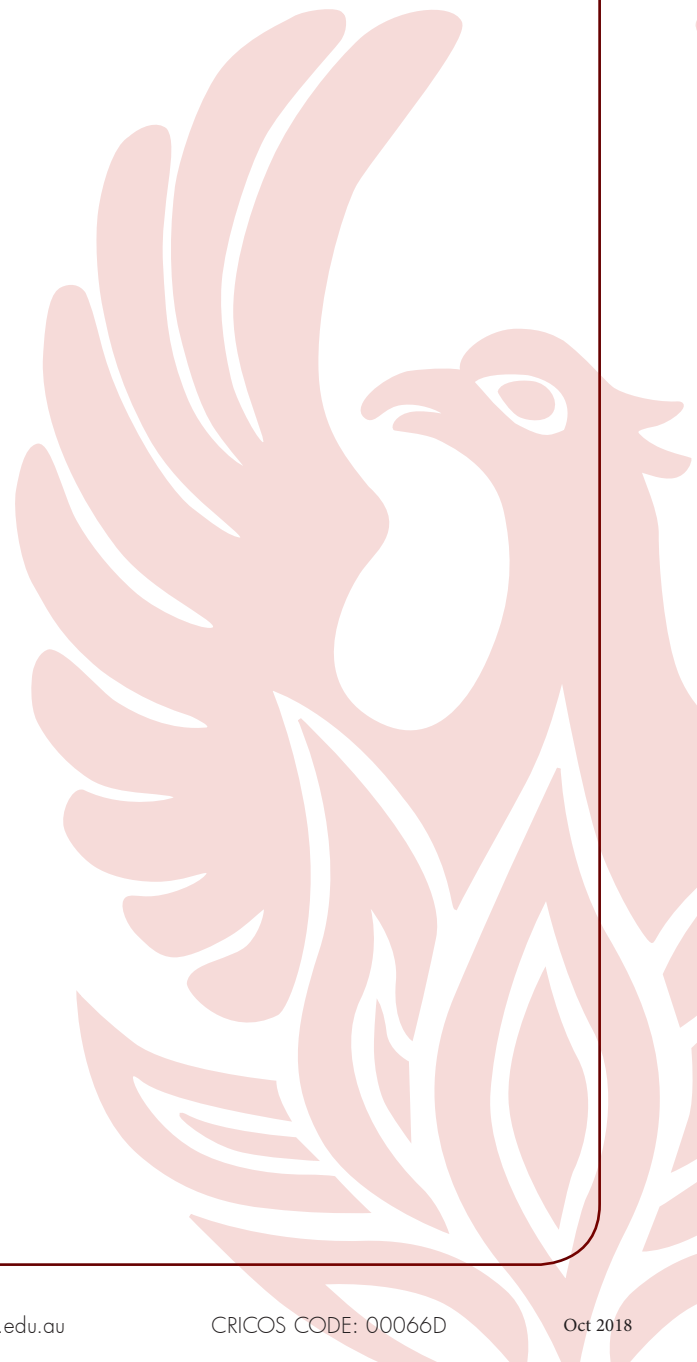

## Low Advanced

### Overview

This course aims at developing the listening and speaking skills necessary to communicate in a health-related context. There is an emphasis on vocabulary, both academic and specific health terminology. There are 4 levels: Level 1 has a focus on General Communication; Level 2 on Taking a Patient's History; Level 3 on Examination and Diagnosis; and Level 4 on Procedures and Treatments.

- explain the consequence of an action
- express degree of possibility
- give instructions
- use language and abbreviations associated with prescribing medication

#### Level 4

At the end of this level, learners are expected to have the knowledge and confidence to:

- ask for and give an opinion
- discuss an opinion to make a decision
- ask for more detailed information

## English for Nursing

### Overview

The English for Nursing online course is aimed at internationally educated nurses studying or intending to study in English speaking countries who require language support at the postsecondary level. The course consists of Nursing focused English instruction, with the emphasis on listening and reading.

### The course has two main sections - Academic Listening & Note Taking Skills

This section includes 6 lessons focusing on academic listening and note-taking skills to help you in your Nursing upgrading courses. All topics relate to the health care field (includes the outlining method, concept mapping, charting, Cornell method).

### Workplace Communication

This section includes four lessons focusing on listening and speaking in nursing contexts such as hospitals, clinics and home visits (including nurse - nurse; nurse - patient; and nurse - family communication strategies).
